What is STAVZOR and how can it help me?

STAVZOR is a brand of valproic acid (also called valproate).

What is unique about STAVZOR?

STAVZOR is an innovative form of valproate that comes in the type of soft gel capsule that is easy to swallow. And, STAVZOR 500 mg is 40% smaller than Depakote/Depakote ER 500 mg tablets. STAVZOR is also available in 125 mg and 250 mg capsules.

In a recent survey, 85% of Depakote/Depakote ER patients said they would have preferred a small soft gel like STAVZOR if it had been available when they started therapy.

Is STAVZOR as effective as Depakote?

Yes, STAVZOR 500 mg capsules are as effective as Depakote 500mg tablets.

How can STAVZOR help me?

The small, easy-to-swallow STAVZOR capsule is designed to help you start and stay on your therapy. Being able to take your medications daily, exactly as your doctor instructed, can help keep the illness under control and reduce the chance of symptoms coming back.

Instructions for Patients:

Present this print out to your pharmacist. It is good for the first **\$50 off** every STAVZOR prescription, including refills.

1. Give your prescription for STAVZOR, along with the Easy Save Pharmacy Card, to your retail pharmacist.
2. If the co-pay cost from your insurance company is \$50 or less, you will pay nothing (\$0). If the cost is more than \$50, you only pay the difference to your pharmacy.
3. Present this printout to your pharmacist and you can use it for every refill as long as you continue taking STAVZOR.

Instructions for Prescribers:

1. Give your eligible patient a valid prescription for STAVZOR. Be sure to mark "dispense as written," "do not substitute," "medically necessary," or as required in your state.
2. Instruct your patient to take the prescription for STAVZOR, along with the attached Easy Save Pharmacy Card, to any retail pharmacy. Remind your patient that the Easy Save Pharmacy Card is good for each and every prescription for STAVZOR, including refills.
3. Please refer to the Eligibility Criteria for more information.

Pharmacy instructions:

Good for patients with authorized third party coverage only. Not valid for individuals enrolled in Medicare, Medicaid, or any other federal or state health care plan. Please submit the claim to the Primary Payor first, then submit the balance due to **Therapy First** as a Secondary Payor as a co-pay billing. The payor amount will be reduced by UP TO \$50 and you receive this plus a handling fee in your next reimbursement from **Therapy First**. Other Coverage Code required. The patient is responsible for the balance if the co-pay amount exceeds \$50. This print out is limited to 1 per patient and is not transferable. One use per month.

Important Safety Information for STAVZOR
(valproic acid delayed release capsules)

WARNING: Life-Threatening Averse Reactions

Liver problems Your doctor should check your liver function before you start taking STAVZOR and at frequent intervals while you're on therapy. If you feel generally ill (malaise), weak, and tired, if your face is swollen and you lose your appetite, and start vomiting, call your doctor immediately.

Pregnancy: Birth defects Women who can become pregnant need to know that valproic acid has been associated with birth defects, in particular with spina bifida, a condition in which the baby's spinal canal fails to close. If you are planning to become pregnant, you should discuss the risks of birth defects, along with other possible treatment options, with your doctor. If you do become pregnant while taking STAVZOR, call your doctor immediately.

Pancreatitis Some people taking valproate have experienced a serious, life-threatening illness called pancreatitis (inflamed pancreas). If you experience stomach pain, nausea, vomiting, and/or loss of appetite, call your doctor immediately.

Common side effects reported in studies with valproate were nausea, drowsiness, vomiting, and dizziness. These are not all the side effects that may occur. You will find a complete list of side effects in the full Prescribing Information. Please be sure to read the entire patient Medication Guide, including side effect information.

For Patients and Caregivers

All antiepileptic medicines, used for any condition, may increase suicidal thoughts or actions in some patients. Pay close attention to any changes, especially sudden changes, in mood, behaviors, thoughts, or feelings. Keep all follow-up visits with the healthcare provider as scheduled. Call the healthcare provider between visits as needed, especially if you have concerns about symptoms.

Watch for and call the healthcare provider right away to report if you or your family member see the appearance or worsening of symptoms of depression, any unusual changes in mood or behavior, or the appearance of suicidal thoughts, behavior, or thoughts about self-harm. Behaviors of concern should be reported immediately to the healthcare provider.

For Healthcare Professionals

All antiepileptic drugs (AEDs), including STAVZOR, increase the risk of suicidal thoughts or behavior in patients taking these drugs for any indication. Anyone considering prescribing Stavzor or any other AED must balance their risk of suicidal thoughts and behavior with the risk of untreated illness.

Patients, their caregivers, and families should be informed that AEDs increase the risk of suicidal thoughts and behavior and should be advised of the need to be alert for the emergence or worsening of the signs and symptoms of depression, any unusual changes in mood or behavior, or the emergence of suicidal thoughts, behavior or thoughts about self-harm. Behaviors of concern should be reported immediately to healthcare providers.
